The OTTAWA FIRE TRUCK PULL will be a fun-filled day the whole family can enjoy! There will be lots of activities in addition to the competition, including the Bytowne Fire Brigade and their antique fire trucks.

It's free to attend. Teams commit to raising at least \$1,000 in charitable donations for their participation.

Registration is now open. You don't have to be a fire fighter to enter, but you can dress like one if you'd like. It will be the weekend before Halloween, after all.

All proceeds from this event will support the nearly 10,000 people with epilepsy in the region.
