Ottawa – On Sunday October 28, teams of 10 will descend on Lansdowne Park to pull a 10 tonne fire truck 100 feet for the inaugural Ottawa Fire Truck Pull. Teams will compete to see who can pull the truck the fastest, raise the most money for a great cause, and demonstrate the best team spirit.

The event kicks off at 2pm with an Honorary Pull team featuring Mayor Jim Watson along with politicians from all levels of government and from across the political spectrum as they pull together for our community.

The Ottawa Fire Truck Pull will be a fun-filled day the whole family can enjoy! There will be lots of activities in addition to the competition, including the Bytowne Fire Brigade and their antique fire trucks.

It's free to attend. Teams commit to raising at least \$1000 in charitable donations for their participation.

Registration is now open. You don't have to be a fire fighter to enter, but you can dress like one if you'd like. It will be the weekend before Halloween, after all.
